When planning a lesson, there are so many things to think about and prepare for.

It is really useful to have some pre-prepared independent tasks ready to go.

Here are some ideas to challenge students who have finished a task.

*You are the expert! **Help** somebody in the class to understand the new learning by:*

- Showing them how to complete a task*
- Showing them an example of what to do*
- Explaining the new information to them again*
- Checking the work they have already done and spotting any mistakes*

***Explain** how what you have learned about today is important to the **real world**.*

Give an example of when it is used outside of school.

*What **knowledge** did you need to know already in order to fully understand today's lesson?*
