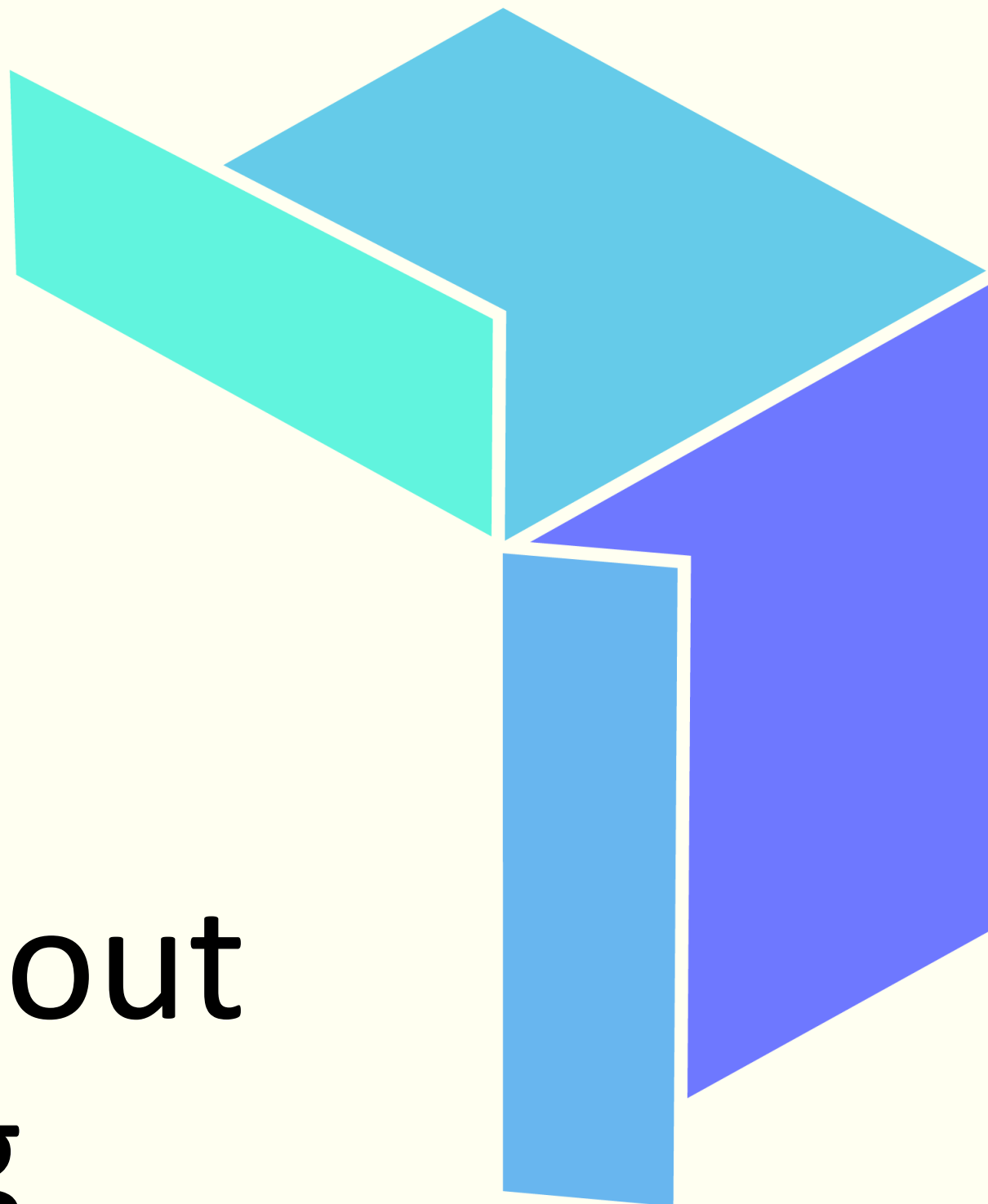

But today, just focus on this...


Moving *AWAY* from your students.

Ask a question, and then when you get a response, take a few steps back.

It is a natural response to move towards the student answering a question.

Then it becomes easy to fall into a back-and-forth conversation with that one student.

This runs the risk of the rest of the class becoming disengaged.



So instead, move away.

Open up the room.

You will be amazed at just how much your body language invites other students into the discussion and keeps engagement high.
