
## grade A classroom





Spot the Difference is an old classic that is seen in many children's activity books...let's bring it to the classroom with a little more challenge.

Find an image to display on the board.

Erase some key parts of the image and give each student a copy of the edited image BEFORE they see the original image on the board.

Give students time to study the image and ponder what might be missing. Student can discuss in pairs. Show the original image on the board for 1 minute and allow students to discuss what they see.

Turn the board off so the image can no longer be seen. Students add the missing parts to their edited copy.

As an additional activity, students can discuss the importance of the parts that were missing.
