

This strategy can be used in a couple of ways...

Write the title of a topic on the board.

e.g. Fractional Distillation of Crude Oil

Students need to

- Recall what it is
- Describe what happens
- Explain how it works

Opportunity to collaborate

Students move around the room and **find someone who can**Recall, Describe and Explain.

Once they have spoken to each other, they can return to their work and improve their answers.

Another use of this strategy

Students create their own Recall, Describe, Explain questions about a topic.

They move around the room and **find someone who can** answer them.

This is good as a revision activity at the end of a topic or as a plenary to review the lesson.
