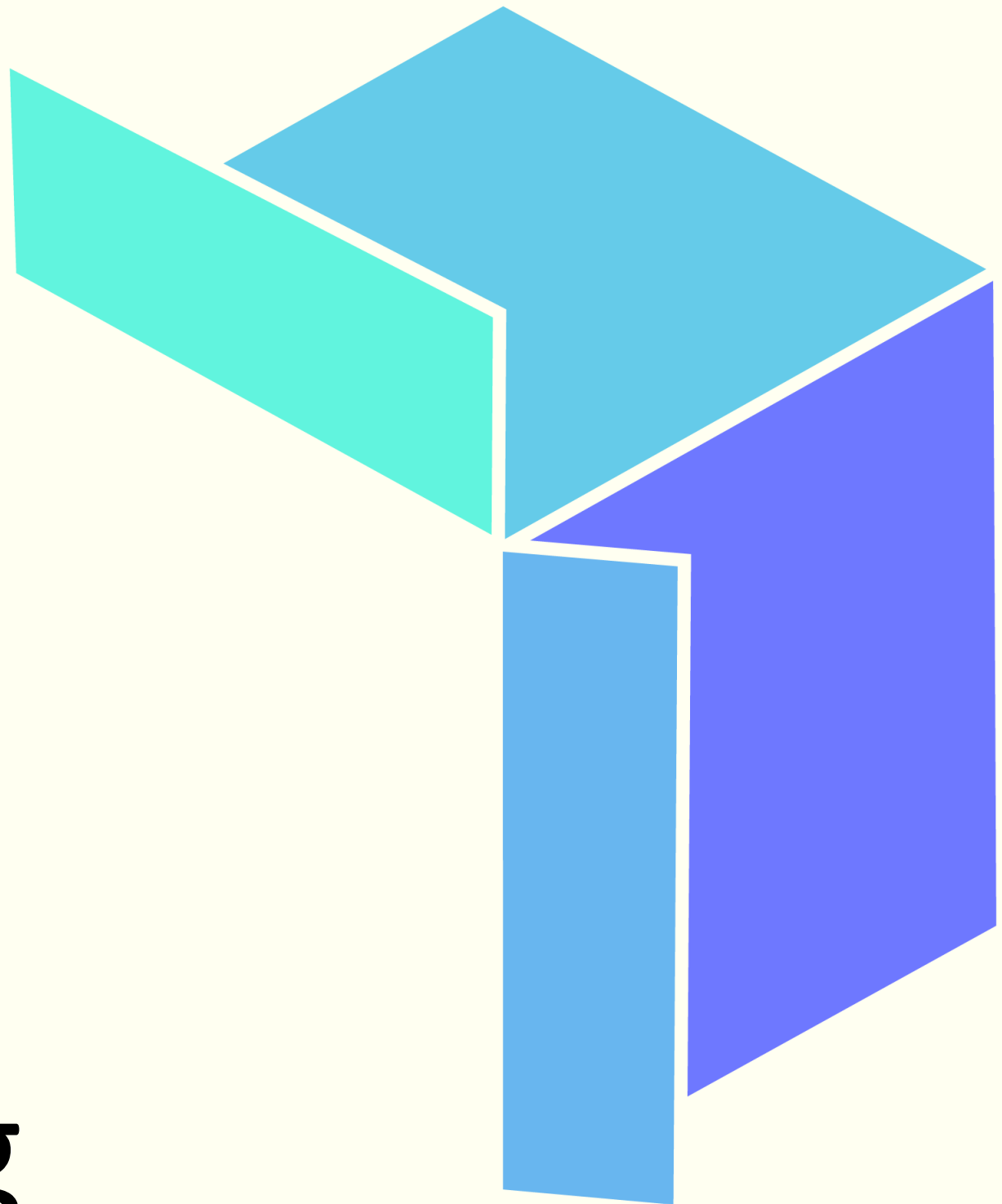


Ask yourself...or ask a colleague...



- What do these terms mean?
- When are they used?
- When are they useful?
- Which of these do you do frequently?
- Which of these could you do more of?
- Do you plan your questioning in advance or do it more ad hoc?
